Chair Report: Kim

- Board Committees

 - Kim will take pictures and Roxy will handle decorations

- RC News

Youth Programming Report

- Attendance concerns for multiple programs
 - RC on the Go in Anna/Jonesboro (0-1 attendees)
 - Robust turnout after anti-LGBTQ issues in Anna years ago
 - Consider other locations in A-J? Art Center? Others
 - Discussion: considering other locations Carrie and Benito will make this decision and move forward
 - Is it time to try for Marion or Harrisburg or Chester instead (and retire Anna)?
 - Benton is relatively new (we've done 2) but we're seeing a little more potential
 - 1 regular attendee, sometimes the Night's Shield comes, too
 - We still have connections with Arrowleaf and the A-J school, so they can reach
 out if the need changes (and make sure Arrowleaf and A-J know we offer gas
 cards for youth to come to programming)
 - Fan-fiction no attendees yet
 - Tutoring
 - Solutions discussed: more outreach, schedule tutors, communicate hours for each subject area in advance
 - Hoping to get City funding for this item [see ED report section]
- Bowling field trip
 - Benito proposes a bowling field trip
 - He estimates 12 people in our bus for Friday (plus people who drive themselves) = 25 total
 - Benito and Roxy will staff this and we will cancel Drop-In that night
 - Kim will check on a potential package deal at SI Bowl
 - Benito will reach out to Scott about using the van for that event
- Rainbow Bucks
 - Benito proposes new system to reward youth for staying to clean up
- Incident report
 - Incident report form for people to fill out and put in a physical box (check the box at the end of programming) include a field that says "do you want us to keep this confidential?"

Executive Director Report: Carrie

- Grants
 - RIG (IPHA) still waiting on updated contract (in the third quarter of this grant already)
 - SIU School of Medicine / Pritzker Foundation: no timeframe
 - Rural Community Center HVC Care: no next steps until June/July
 - [applying] Public Health Institute of Metropolitan Chicago (PHIMC): \$150k transgender health
 - [applying] Smoking Cessation
 - [applying] City of Carbondale funding application: \$20k to help cover after-school hours
 - Next Executive Director report will spell out abbreviations and note which grants are active vs. in the application stage
- Clinical Center updates from Carrie
 - Services will be operational within one month
 - Carrie and Claire will be providing clinical services, pending discussion of Claire's job title, hourly rate, and hours of availability
- Youth programming age range
 - Drop-in will become 13-18 years old
 - Elevate will become 18-25 years old

Money Report: Carrie

- Taxes
 - 990 and tax documents for 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 are now signed
 - Amanda will be submitting these forms ASAP
 - Catching up because we were doing (1) postcard 990s and (2) not doing state 990s
 - 2023 taxes are in progress now, can file extension for later this year
- Budget
 - Switching from cash to accrual budget, which is a better fit for our grant-funded work
 - Annual budget will be ready for review at the March board meeting: Carrie will work with Amanda to finalize this, and Carrie will present
